EPHESUS Revelation 2:1-7	Holds the seven stars and walks among the lampstands (2:1).	Hard work, endurance, discernment, resistance to false teaching (2:2-3, 6). But they abandoned their first love (2:4).	Remember, repent, and do the works you did at first (2:5).	Eat from the tree of life in God's paradise (2:7).
SMYRNA Revelation 2:8-11	The First and the Last, who was dead and came to life (2:8).	Affliction, poverty, slander, yet Jesus calls them rich (2:9). No rebuke.	Do not be afraid. Be faithful to the point of death (2:10).	The crown of life, and the second death cannot harm them (2:10-11).
PERGAMUM Revelation 2:12-17	The One with the sharp, double-edged sword (2:12).	They hold fast to Jesus' name even after Antipas was killed (2:13), but they tolerate the compromise of Balaam and the Nicolaitans (2:14-15).	Repent (2:16).	Hidden manna, a white stone, and a new name (2:17).

THYATIRA Revelation 2:18-29	The Son of God, with eyes like fire and feet like fine bronze (2:18).	Love, faithfulness, service, and endurance that is growing, not fading (2:19). But they tolerate a false teacher who leads people into sin (2:20).	Hold on to what you have until I come (2:25).	Authority over the nations, and the morning star (2:26-28).
SARDIS Revelation 3:1-6	The One who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars (3:1).	A reputation for being alive, but they are dead (3:1). A few have kept their clothes clean (3:4).	Be alert. Strengthen what remains, remember what you received, and repent (3:2-3).	White clothes, a name that is never erased from the book of life, and Jesus acknowledging that name before the Father (3:5).
PHILADELPHIA Revelation 3:7-13	The Holy One, the True One, who holds the key of David and opens what no one can close (3:7).	Little power, but they kept his word and did not deny his name (3:8). No rebuke.	Hold on to what you have, so that no one takes your crown (3:11).	A pillar in God's temple, marked with the name of God, the new Jerusalem, and Jesus' new name (3:12).
LAODICEA Revelation 3:14-22	The Amen, the faithful and true witness, the originator of God's creation (3:14).	Lukewarm. They say they are rich and need nothing, but Jesus says they are poor, blind, and naked (3:15-17).	Buy from me what you actually need. Be zealous and repent. Open the door (3:18-20).	A seat with Jesus on his throne (3:21).
