The Director of Student Ministry supports the mission of Sojourn Church J-Town by partnering with parents to reach, build, and send students with the gospel. This role will lead the charge in shaping our students through providing gospel-centered teaching, space for healthy friendships, and other adults in their life to help them follow Jesus.

Ministry to Students: Oversee all aspects of ministry within Sojourn Students including vision/direction, programming, discipleship, and administration.

- Implement and regularly cast a long-term vision for engaging and discipling students both within the ministry and with the church at large. Lead with passion and clarity.
- Establish, plan, and execute all elements for a welcoming and engaging gathering for students (Grades 6-12) weekly.
- Develop a teaching calendar that takes into consideration the multi-layered needs of students and oversee all related curriculum.
- Recruit, train, develop, mobilize, and connect regularly with a student ministry team of volunteers who are empowered for the work of the ministry in various capacities.
- Plan and lead students in age-appropriate serving experiences, both inside and outside of our church, throughout the year.
- Plan and execute various student events throughout the year.
- Work with the Sojourn Kids staff in coordinating a seamless transition for children moving up from Sojourn Kids to Sojourn Students.
- Manage an annual student ministry budget and related fundraising initiatives.


Ministry to Parents: Foster an environment of encouragement and equipping for parents.

- Keep parents informed and involved in all that is going on in the ministry through effective avenue(s) of communication.
 - $\circ\quad$ Send weekly clear and compelling communication to parents.
 - o Distribute additional timely and helpful communication to parents as needed.
- Meet with parents regularly to encourage and pray with them.
- Create learning spaces and share resources for the purpose of equipping parents.
- Oversee the baptism process for students 18 and under including family baptism classes, advocacy, and post-baptism follow-up.
- Partner with Sojourn Kids in other milestone-related classes and events.

Discipleship: In partnership with the Associate Pastor, help to give oversight to the discipleship ministries of Sojourn J-Town.

- Give oversight to various learning spaces including classes and training.
- Assist in developing curriculum for learning spaces.
- As gifting and Sunday gathering needs align, preach 1-4 times a year on Sunday mornings.
