Mission Connection

The vision of Sojourn Church Midtown is to *reach* people with the gospel, *build* them together as a multi-cultural church, and *send* them as witnesses into their neighborhoods and the nations. To that end, Sojourn College Staff further Sojourn's vision among Louisville's college students. In other words, we want to see college students give their lives to Jesus, trained up to love Him with their whole being, and sent out to make disciples for the rest of their lives, whether that be overseas, as part of a church plant, or in Louisville.

Responsibilities

Staff Member

- Presence and participation in Midtown and SC staff meetings/trainings
- Attend and engage students at SC Gathered/Late Nights
- Serve at bi-weekly student Leader Huddles
- Help plan and participate in student events and trips
- Regular coaching meetings with Director or Sojourn College
- Irregular meetings with students, outside of discipleship meetings, as the need arises

Social Events

- Responsible and accountable for Senior Sendoff, Fall Retreat, Spring Break Trip, and other social events and trips
- Assist in the planning and execution of our 8-week summer missions intern program, The Acts 1:8 Project
- Responsible for planning staff leader hangouts, monthly

Discipleship

- Prepare and lead 2-3 female discipleship groups that meet weekly

Church and Campus Relations

- Responsible for maintaining good standing as an RSO with UofL
- Work with mercy ministry representatives in each CG, determine service opportunities that work with the schedules and passions for each CG
- Organize one SC Women’s ministry event per semester. Lead through upperclassmen and utilize godly older women in Sojourn congregation

Character and Competencies

- Fulfill the character and qualifications of a deacon as outlined in Scripture and the Sojourn Constitution
- Conviction and ability to make disciples who make disciples
- Self-aware, understands gifts and limitations
- Demonstrates humility and a desire to learn and grow
- Has a long view for SC students — desires and works towards them being life long disciples, not simply while they are in college
- Embodies the six Sojourn Church Midtown values: biblical faithfulness, gospel-centeredness, transformative relationships, diverse fellowship, creativity and the arts, and relentless mission
- Demonstrated organizational gifting and experience with planning events
- Embody the Sojourn Church Midtown vision, as adapted for Sojourn College

Expectations

- Maintains a lifestyle that represents the gospel and is above reproach
- Adheres to the Sojourn College staff covenant
- Aims to work 25 hours per week (40-45 hours if full time)
- All Sojourn College staff are support raised – the applicant must be willing to raise and maintain their own funds for this role
- Commit to at least 2 years in this role
